(4) Full justification for increasing the intake of MBBS course :

The Dean, ESIC Medical College & Hospital, ESI Corporation, K.K. Nagar, Chennai has applied for increasing the annual intake of MBBS course from 100 to 150 seats. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Tamil Nadu has decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant for increasing the annual intake of MBBS course from 100 to 150 seats subject to the condition that, 65% of the seats should be allotted to State Government for admission to MBBS course under Single Window System through the Selection Committee of this State and also to obtained the Pollution Control Board certificate before the National Medical Commission inspection.

It is certified that:-

- a) It is desirable to increase the annual intake in MBBS course from 100 to 150 seats in the public interest.
- b) Increasing the annual intake in MBBS course from 100 to 150 seats by ESIC Medical College & Hospital, K.K.Nagar, Chennai is feasible.
- c) The institution has 830 number of teaching beds with the standing of 10 years.
- d) The average OPD strength per day is 3200.
- e) The average bed occupancy is 66.5%.
- f) The affiliated teaching hospital is unitary in character.
- g) The number of teaching beds, average OPD strength and average bed occupancy available at ESIC Medical College & Hospital, K.K.Nagar, Chennai is not less than the criteria prescribed under the "Opening of a New or Higher Course of Study or Training (including Post Graduate course of Study or Training) and increase of Admission Capacity in any course of study or Training (including a Post Graduate course of Study or Training) Regulations, 2000".

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the course as per National Medical Commission norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the above said course at this college with the permission of the Central Government.
